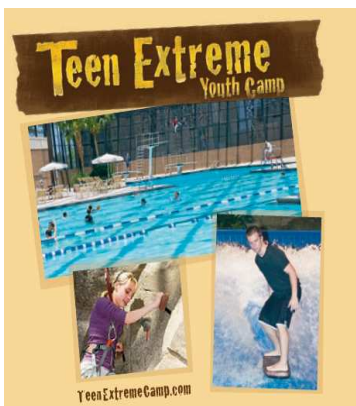

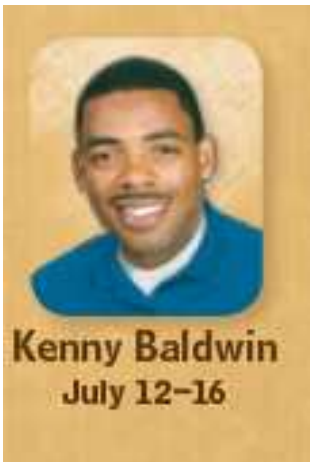

GENERAL INFORMATION

Teen Extreme Youth Camp is conducted in a Christian environment enjoying the Sports Center facilities on the Pensacola Christian College campus in Pensacola, Florida. While providing a time of fun and friendship with other Christian teens, Teen Extreme Youth Camp provides excellent emphasis on spiritual development with Bible preaching in daily chapel services.

Accommodations: Pensacola Christian College residence halls are attractively furnished, carpeted, air-conditioned, and equipped with adjoining bath.

What to Bring: Bible, notebook, pencil, towels, pillow, linens for a single bed (or sleeping bag), an umbrella, and spending money for camp souvenirs, paintball, camp photos, etc.

Boys may wear casual pants, wind pants or jeans to all activities. Shorts may be worn in Field House, Sports Arena, and athletic fields. Long pants are to be worn for evening services. Shirts should not have inappropriate pictures or writing. Swim wear should be trunk-style only (no speedo type). Hair should be neat, trimmed,

and off the collar. Jewelry other than rings or a watch may not be worn.

Girls may wear culottes or loose-fitting or athletic-style, knee-length walking shorts for all activities and wind pants for the climbing wall and in-line/ice skating. Skirts are to be worn for evening services. Please no slacks, jeans, capri pants, short shorts, or midriff tops. Low necklines (front or back) are not appropriate attire. Shirts should not have inappropriate pictures or writing. Swimsuits should be modest and one-piece.

Teen Extreme Youth Camp/Youth Outreach Ministry reserves the right to ask anyone to change his or her clothing if, in the opinion of the staff, it does not comply with these standards.

Arrival and Departure: THE TBC BUS WILL LEAVE FROM CHURCH IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE SUNDAY NIGHT SERVICE ON JULY 11TH. Check-in is Monday 12–2:30 p.m. (CT), with first activity beginning at 3 p.m. The first meal is served Monday night. Checkout is noon on Friday.

How to Apply:

Enrollments are limited. Submit your application and waiver (attached) along with the registration fee and any roommate requests as soon as possible to ensure your reservation. If you need more applications, you may make copies or download additional copies at templebc.org.

Cost:

Each camper's cost of \$170 (PLUS REGISTRATION FEE) includes housing, meals, and all activities except paintball (additional charge of \$10 per session). The remaining balance will be paid ON DATE OF DEPARTURE FOR CAMP: Non-refundable registration fees are listed below.

Rock Climbing, FlowRider®, and Paintball Waiver and Release

(Must be completed by each applicant, including sponsors, and sent with application)

I understand and agree that I am assuming for myself and the Participant named below all risk of injury from participating in rock climbing activities, surfing on the FlowRider® or paintball games. I understand that: (1) injuries while rock climbing may occur from rope entanglements, objects falling from or being dropped by other climbers, or from contact with anchor points, bolts, or equipment used in climbing; (2) injuries while using the FlowRider® may occur by falling or being thrown by the water pressure onto a fixed surface or padded retaining wall, or by contact with the body board; (3) the activities of paintball are physically and mentally intense, injuries while participating in paintball games may occur due to the activity and weaponry involved, and while particular protective equipment and personal discipline will minimize the risk, the risk of injury does exist and (4) other unforeseeable injuries may occur from these activities. I hereby waive, release, and agree not to sue Youth Outreach Ministry, Inc., Pensacola Christian College, Inc., its affiliates or subsidiaries, and any of their officers, directors, employees, agents, students, successors, or assigns for any damage, injury, cost, or cause of action arising from any participation in these activities.

I voluntarily sign this waiver, release and agreement not to sue with full knowledge of the nature and extent of the risks inherent in the use of the rock climbing wall, FlowRider®, and paintball. I further indemnify and save Youth Outreach Ministry, Inc., Pensacola Christian College and its affiliates, employees, and agents harmless from any liability or medical payments resulting from my child's participating in this camp or other activities during his or her stay at summer camp. I further understand that Youth Outreach Ministry, Inc. does not provide medical insurance coverage for my child and any medical expense incurred will be paid by me or my insurance. I hereby grant permission for my child to attend the camp, participate in all the camp activities, and to be treated by a licensed medical professional in the event of any injury, accident or illness or other situation that may require medical attention. I give permission for my child's picture to be used in future publications including publications from PCC and its affiliate web pages. I understand the enclosed registration fee is nonrefundable and nontransferable. Campers that use tobacco, alcohol or any form of illegal drugs will be dismissed. Any non-cooperative or non-compliant campers will be subject to dismissal.
